Gifts and benefits above \$100 received by the Inspector-General and employees

In accordance with Australian Public Service Commission (APSC) Guidelines on gifts and benefits, Agency heads (including departmental secretaries) must not accept gifts or benefits which might reasonably be seen to compromise their integrity.

Agency heads must publish a register of gifts and benefits they accept, and all gifts or benefits accepted (valued at over \$AUD100 ex GST) must be publicly disclosed. The register is updated quarterly.
